






Interest in hedge fund strategies has not changed much since YE18





July hedge fund trading flows by global sector (vs. MSCI World Sector Price Returns)





Global search activity for "welfare & unemployment" growing for first time since crisis




Bigger bank holdings: Different holders of DM government debt, 1901-2018





Searches for "recession" bursting across the globe





World trade volumes about to decline significantly for the first time since the financial crisis






Safehouse: China has household debt levels approaching those of advanced economies




"IIF Green Flows Tracker" reports USD 2bn inflows for Q2, with record-high inflows in June



The unemployment rate since 1890







Back to QE: Major central banks set to switch back to net purchases this year




US growth has diverged from the rest of the world. Is it sustainable?





The big five technology firms have spent billions buying rivals in recent years












Money-market assets are the highest since 2009





The future of AI: Forecasted cumulative global AI revenue 2016-2025, by use case (in USD)







Local is losing: Share of industry assets, by bank asset size






Retirement savings gap: Estimated years of life expectancy past retirement savings, by country



Amazon, the new king of shipping: Share of Amazon shipments by carrier




Time it took for the world population to increase by one billion




Beef has the biggest carbon footprint - but the same food can have a range of impacts



Not made in the US: Annual CO2 emissions in tons










The average age of Brazilians is now set to rise faster than that of many other countries' residents



Asian-American and Pacific Islander community could prove decisive in early 2020 caucus




Catholics were more accepting of transgender people than were members of other Christian groups

Rising toll: Suicides per 100,000 people aged 18 to 34




China is leading a global surge in surveillance technology

Number of patents published worldwide that mention facial recognition or surveillance cameras in the title or abstract, by country of patent author(s)














Where super rich populations are growing fastest








Tesla dominates electric car sales in the United States




